If you are required to report for additional days of jury service at any court location, you may elect to receive transit passes by waiving the daily mileage reimbursement for a Day Pass each additional day you serve. The program is explained during your juror orientation.

If you are required to report for additional days of jury service, you may elect to continue to receive the transit benefit by exchanging the daily mileage reimbursement for a Day Pass each additional day you serve. The program is explained during your juror orientation.

We encourage you to take public transit when reporting for Jury Duty in downtown. The best solution is to buy a Day Pass. Day Passes on Compass Cards are sold at any Trolley, SPRINTER or COASTER ticket machine. If you have a Compass Card you can load a Day Pass on it on most MTS Bus, *Rapid*, and *Rapid* Express and NCTD BREEZE routes.
