**GENERAL ORDER OF THE
PRESIDING DEPARTMENT**

ORDER NO. 010126-13

In accordance with the authority vested in the Presiding Judge under California Rules of Court, rule 10.603, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. All Title IV-D Child Support Commissioners are authorized to order the transfer of actions, proceedings, and/or hearings involving the Department of Child Support Services to any other Title IV-D department and/or division of this court.

2. All actions and/or proceedings involving the Department of Child Support Services and in which both parents/parties reside in the North County filing area are hereby transferred to the North County Division for all purposes.

3. All actions and/or proceedings involving the Department of Child Support Services and in which one parent/party resides in the North County filing area and the other parent/party resides outside of the County of San Diego are hereby transferred to the North County Division for all purposes.

1 4. All Title IV-D Child Support Commissioners are authorized to order the transfer
2 of actions and/or proceedings involving the Department of Child Support Services to the North
3 County Division where at least one parent/party resides in the North County filing area, and where
4 good cause is shown.

5 5. All Title IV-D Child Support Commissioners are authorized to order the transfer
6 of actions and/or proceedings involving the Department of Child Support Services to the North
7 County Division when there is a finding of good cause for ordering such transfer, regardless of
8 whether one or both parents/parties reside in the North County filing area.


9 6. Notwithstanding this order, all documents electronically filed by the Department
10 of Child Support Services may use either the North County or Central Division address.

11 This order shall become effective on January 1, 2026, and expire on December 31, 2026,
12 unless otherwise ordered by this court.

13 Service of this order is ordered on the Department of Child Support Services.
