## THIS COURT FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

The San Diego Superior Court, Legal Aid Society of San Diego, Inc. (hereafter "LASSD"), and San Diego Volunteer Lawyer Program (hereinafter "SDVLP") are participating in the Sargent Shriver Civil Counsel Project approved by the Judicial Council in accordance with the Sargent Shriver Civil Counsel Act, Government Code section 68650 et seq. (hereinafter "Shriver Project") whereby LASSD will provide representation to eligible parties in unlawful detainer cases, and SDVLP will provide limited representation to eligible parties in certain child custody cases filed in Family Court in any Division of the court, and assistance and/or limited representation in domestic violence restraining order cases filed in the Central and North County Divisions.

As part of the Shriver Project, parties in unlawful detainer matters may be ordered by the court to attend a mandatory settlement conference, and parties in certain child custody cases may be ordered by the court to attend a Shriver Settlement Conference. Certain domestic violence
