IN RE ASSIGNMENT OF CASES SEEKING WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS CHALLENGING CERTAIN ISOLATION OR QUARANTINE ORDERS GENERAL ORDER OF THE PRESIDING DEPARTMENT

ORDER NO. 010126-31

Pursuant to California Rules of Court, rule 10.603, notwithstanding any local rule or other provision of law to the contrary, to ensure the efficient handling of petitions for writs of habeas corpus challenging certain isolation or quarantine orders issued by the Public Health Officer of the County of San Diego or his/her designee in response to a communicable or infectious disease outbreak that has been declared an emergency pursuant to the California Emergency Services Act, the court HEREBY FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Any petition seeking a writ of habeas corpus under Penal Code section 1473, or other relief, that challenges isolation, quarantine, or other orders issued by the Public Health Officer of the County of San Diego or his/her designee in response to a communicable or infectious disease outbreak resulting in a declared emergency shall be filed in the Central Courthouse and assigned

to the Presiding Judge or, in the event the Presiding Judge is unavailable, to the Assistant Presiding Judge. The Presiding Judge may also assign any and/or all such writs of habeas corpus, for all purposes, to the Supervising Judge of Criminal, the Supervising Judge of Civil, or the Assistant Supervising Judge of Criminal, located at the Central Courthouse, 1100 Union Street, San Diego, California.

This order shall become effective on January 1, 2026, and expire on December 31, 2026, unless otherwise ordered by this court.
