IN RE ESTABLISHMENT OF HOURLY RATE FOR CONVERTING A FINE ON AN INFRACTION TO COMMUNITY SERVICE GENERAL ORDER OF THE PRESIDING DEPARTMENT ORDER NO. 010126-34

THIS COURT FINDS AND ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

Penal Code section 1209.5 permits a person convicted of an infraction, upon a showing that payment of the total fine would pose a hardship, to elect to perform community service in lieu of paying the total fine that would otherwise be imposed. The hourly rate applicable to community service is set forth in section 1209.5, subdivision (c)(1), and is double the minimum wage set for the calendar year, as established by Labor Code section 1182.12, subdivision (b)(2). Pursuant to section 1182.12, California's statewide minimum wage will be \$16.90 per hour, effective January 1, 2026. The hourly rate applicable to community service will thus be \$33.80. Section 1290.5, subdivision (b)(2), authorizes the court to increase this amount.

Pursuant to the authority set forth in Penal Code section 1209.5 and California Rules of Court, rule 10.603, the court hereby increases the amount that is credited for each hour of community service performed pursuant to section 1209.5 to \$34 per hour.

This order shall become effective on January 1, 2026, and expire on December 31, 2026, unless otherwise ordered by this court.
